Austin Honour is a British/Australian multidisciplinary artist who's work collages conventions of painting, sculpture and tattooing. Honour works within a holistic studio practice which aims to connect media, concept and form.

Blue Room is an exhibition of recent paintings which stem from an engagement with found imagery often depicting objects of history and nature.

Interested in ideologies of and the interplay between history, material and value, Honour questions how contemporary cultures classify what is deemed important or even crucial, and encourages a deeper investigation into this.

By veiling the works through a coloured lens, harking back as a pastiche of Picasso's blue period and Yves Klein, Honour flattens an otherwise accepted potential hierarchy between subject matters and levels the playing field anew for the audience.

Previously located in Berlin, Honour is now based in Perth, Australia. Honour was awarded a BA (Hons) Fine Arts from Central St Martins in London in 2014.

This is Honour's first solo exhibition.




